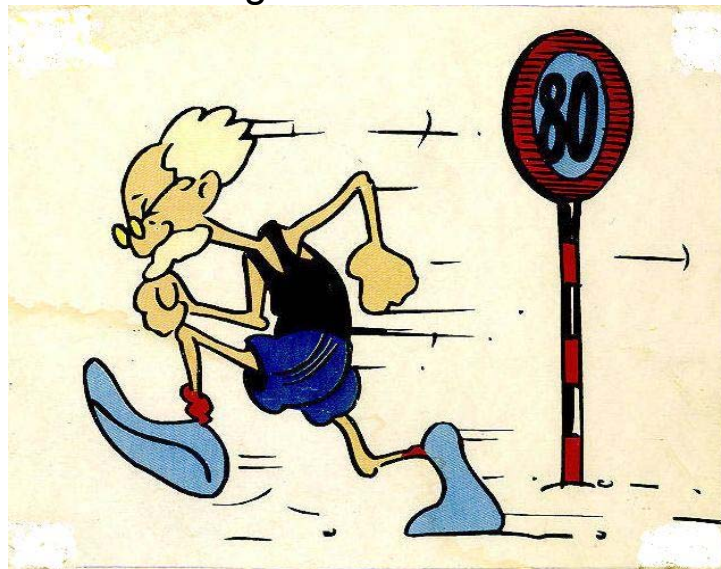

BALKAN VETERAN CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS **Belgrade, 29 April 2012**

The CITY



Belgrade is the capital and largest city of Serbia. It is also one of the oldest cities in Europe. The first settlements in the Belgrade area date from prehistoric Vinča, 4800 BC. Belgrade itself was founded by the Celts in the 3rd century BC before it became a Roman settlement. The Slavic name "Beligrad" (Slov. Bjelgrad) was first recorded in 878. The impression of the former fortress looks is contained in this name. Belgrade has been the capital of Serbia since 1405 and it was the capital of various South Slavic states from 1918 to 2003, and Serbia and Montenegro from 2003 to 2006.

The city lies at the confluence of the Sava and the Danube in central Serbia, where the Pannonian Plain meets the Balkan Peninsula. Population in Belgrade, according to the census from 2011, was 1,154,589 and 1,639,121 people lived in the wider region. It is the largest city in the former Yugoslavia and the fourth most populated in Southeast Europe after Istanbul, Athens and Bucharest.

Belgrade has the status of a separate territorial unit in Serbia with its local government. Its territory is divided into 17 urban municipalities, each with its local government. Belgrade takes more than 3.6% of the territory of the Republic of Serbia, and within its boundaries live 21% of the total number of citizens of Serbia who took part in the census of 2002 (without data for Kosovo and Metohija). Belgrade is also the economic center of Serbia and the center of Serbian culture, education and science.

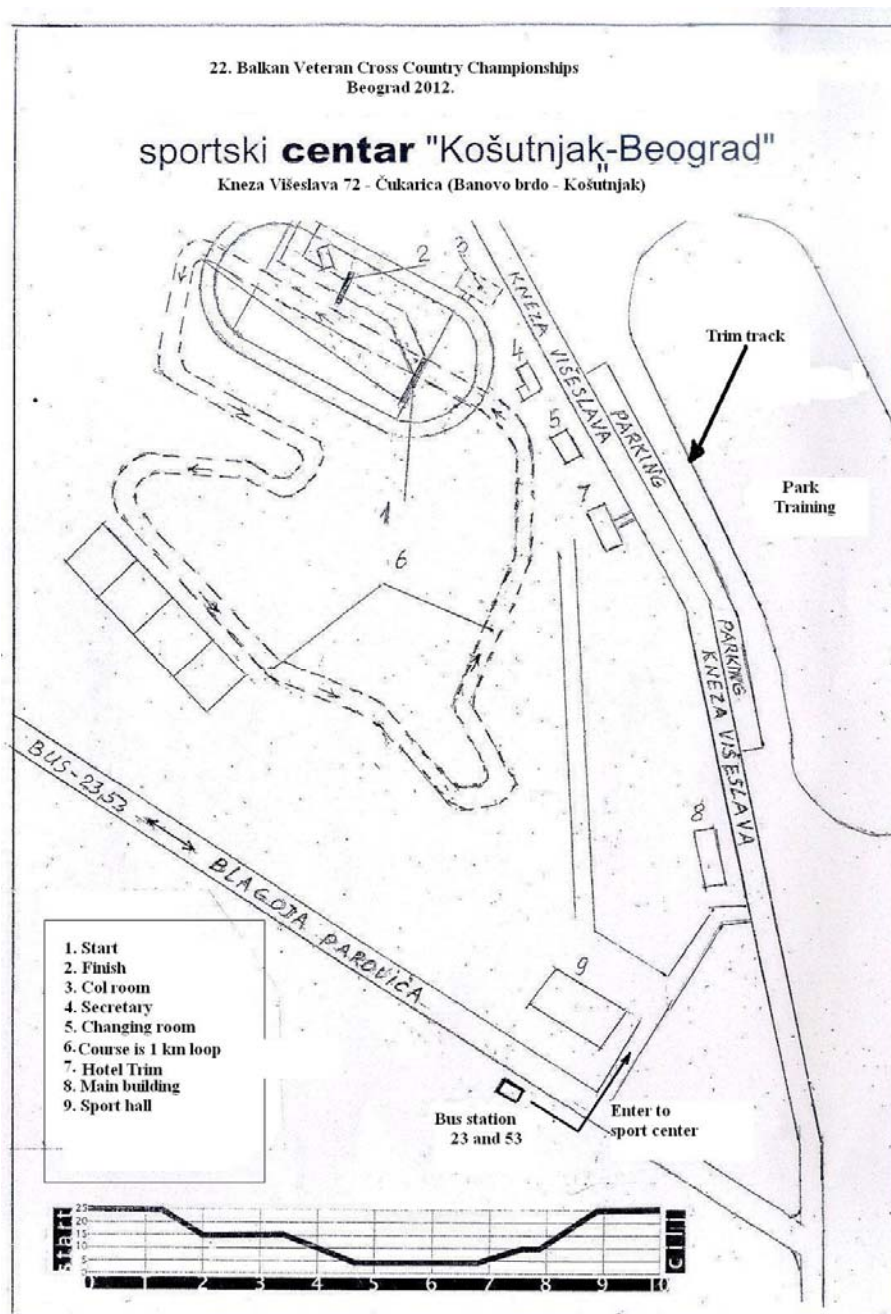
